

## VILLAGE ORDINANCE

An ordinance providing for the licensing of chauffeurs and drivers of automobiles, public porters, liverymen, hackmen, cartmen and dray-drivers.

The Village Board of the Village of Weyerhauser, Rusk County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

### SECTION NO. 1

No person shall engage in or follow the business of chauffeur, driver of automobile or other similar motor vehicle, public porter, liveryman, hackman, cartman or driver of a dray in the Village of Weyerhauser, Wisconsin, for hire without having first paid the Village Treasurer the license fee and received from the Village Clerk a license authorizing him so to do as hereinafter provided.

### SECTION NO. 2

The license fee mentioned in Section No. 1 shall be the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars and shall be paid to the Village Treasurer. The Village Clerk upon presentation of the treasurer's receipt therefor shall issue to each applicant a license authorizing him to engage in and follow the businesses mentioned in said Section No. 1 in the Village of Weyerhauser. All said licenses shall expire on December thirty-first of each year.

### SECTION NO. 3

All persons engaging in or following any of the businesses mentioned in Section No. 1 and who shall reside in said Village of Weyerhauser and all such persons who shall remain in said Village of Weyerhauser continuously for five days are required to procure said license.

### SECTION NO. 4

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be adjudged to pay a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50) dollars nor more than One hundred (\$100) dollars and the costs of prosecution, and shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Rusk County until such judgment be paid, not exceeding, however, ninety days.
