to incorporate territory in said County into a Villiage by the name of
Weyerhaeuser.

Upon the application and petition of Frank L. Lineberg, M. A. Anderson, H. Christenson, John Anderson and E. J. Erickson taxpayers and residents of the territory therein described and situate in the county of Rusk and state of Wisconsin and hereinafter described, dated the 1st day of Dec. 1906, wherein they pray that an order be made by said court incorporating said territory into a villiage by the name of Weyerhaeuser and the survey, map and census and the affidavits verifying the same and the affidavit that they were left and kept subject to examination as provided in section 856 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1898, and a copy of the notice of said application with the affidavit of the posting of the same thereon and thereto affixed as provided for in section 858 of the said Statues, all being to said petition duly annexed as provided for by section 859 of said Statutes: and due proof having been made that due and timely notice of the hearing of said application and petition would be had before said court at the time and place therein specified and designated, and the court having, at the said time and place so mentioned in said notice taken up the hearing thereof and heard the same upon all the papers and proceedings had, taken or filed therein and the allegations of the parties interested therein, and upon and after such hearing, the court aforesaid being fully satisfied of the correctness of such survey of said territory and of the said census and that all the requirements of the statutes of Wisconsin have been complied with, and that such territory at is proposed to be included in said villiage, contained at the time such census therof was first taken, the population in numbers and proportion and the quantity of land therein required in section 854 of the said Statutes of Wisconsin, and that all the provisions of Chapter 40 of the said Statutes and the acts ammendatory thereto relating to the incorporation of new villiages have been duly and

Miller of the town of Stubbs in said county of Rusk in which said territory above particularly described lies, be, and they are hereby named and appointed as and to perform the duties of inspectors of election as required by the provisions of said Chapter 40 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1898 and the acts amendatory thereto.
