

VILLAGE OF WEYERHAEUSER, RUSK COUNTY, WISCONSIN
CHARTER ORDINANCE 08-001 PROVIDING FOR THE
APPOINTMENT OF A VILLAGE CLERK AND A VILLAGE TREASURER

The Village Board of the Village of Weyerhaeuser, Rusk County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Charter Ordinance #08-001 of the Village of Weyerhaeuser is hereby created to provide as follows:

01-002 **APPOINTMENT OF VILLAGE CLERK AND VILLAGE TREASURER**

- (1) **CHANGE IN SELECTION METHOD/VILLAGE CLERK.** Pursuant to secs. 61.0195, 61.197, and 66.0101, Wis. Stats, the Village hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of secs. 61.19, 61.23 and 61.25(2), Wis. Stats, which relate to the selection and tenure of the Village Clerk, and which are in conflict with this section.
- (2) **APPOINTMENT/VILLAGE CLERK.** The Village Clerk shall be appointed by the Village President at the Village Board's organizational meeting in April in odd numbered years, subject to confirmation by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the members of the Village Board. The Village Clerk shall hold office for a two (2) year term, subject to removal as provided by law. Provided, however, that the initial appointment of the Village Clerk following Village incorporation shall be for a term commencing with the date of the appointment and ending at the Village Board's organizational meeting in April of the year 2009.
- (3) **CLERK'S DUTIES.** The Village Clerk shall perform the statutory duties of Village Clerk and such other duties as required by the Village Board from time to time.
- (4) **CHANGE IN SELECTION METHOD/VILLAGE TREASURER.** Pursuant to secs. 61.195, 61.197 and 66.0101, Wis. Stats., the Village hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of secs. 61.19 and 61.23, Wis. Stats., which relate to the selection and tenure of the Village Treasurer, and which are in conflict with this section
- (5) **APPOINTMENT/VILLAGE TREASURER.** The Village Treasurer shall be appointed by the Village President at the Village organizational meeting in April in odd numbered years, subject to confirmation by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the members of the Village Board. The Village Treasurer shall hold office for a two (2)
