

ORDINANCE NO. 1.07A ATV'S

An Ordinance to establish an all-terrain vehicle ordinance pursuant to Section 23.33 (8) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The Village Board of the Village of Weyerhaeuser, State of Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish an all-terrain vehicle route and provide safe and enjoyable all-terrain vehicle recreation consistent with public rights and interests.

SECTION II.

Travel by ATV on or adjacent to any Village Street or roadway will be at the rate of speed not to exceed ten (10) miles per hour.

SECTION III.

No person under the age of twelve (12) years of age shall operate an ATV on or within the traveled portion of any street, alleyway or roadway.

SECTION IV.

Any ATV operated upon any Village street, alleyway or roadway shall do so with the flow of traffic and on the extreme right side of such street, alleyway or roadway and shall have the front headlights and taillights on and operating properly.

SECTION V.

The operator of an ATV shall yield to all vehicular traffic when operating on or crossing a Village Street, alleyway, or roadway.

SECTION VI.

This ordinance does not affect State or County roadways, nor does it supersede State Laws pertaining to ATV use, except as to Village streets and alleyways. State Laws will be adhered to where this ordinance fails to provide otherwise.

SECTION VII.

Operating ATV is prohibited within the area designated for travel near any church property on Sunday mornings between the hours of 8 A.M. and 12 noon.

SECTION VIII.

Operation and use of ATV's is prohibited in the Weyerhaeuser Cemetery proper.

SECTION IX

No person shall operate an ATV on any sidewalk or pedestrian-way within the Village limits.

SECTION X.

No person shall operate an ATV on any private property not owned or controlled by him within the Village of Weyerhaeuser without the express consent or permission of the owner.

SECTION XI.

AREAS DESIGNATED: All streets and highways within the Village limits are hereby designated as all-terrain vehicle routes and shall be open to all-terrain vehicles on a year round basis. The areas, streets and highways shall be designated by all-terrain vehicle route signs having a reflectorized white all-terrain vehicle symbol, bordered and messaged on a reflectorized green background with a minimum size of 24" x 18" and with directional arrows, where appropriate, placed at the beginning of an all-terrain vehicle route and at such locations and intervals as necessary to enable the all-terrain vehicle operators to follow the route or routes.

SECTION XII.

ENFORCEMENT: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by an officer of the State Traffic Patrol under Section 110.07 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes, an inspector under Section 110.07 (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, a conservation warden appointed by the Department of Natural Resources under Section 23.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes, County Sheriff, Sheriff's Deputy or Municipal Police Officer.


SECTION XIII.


