ORDINANCE NO. 1-66

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR SEWER SERVICE DURING PERIODS OF VACANCY.

Ordinance No. 1-54 adopted January 15, 1954 established the charges for service of the municipal sewer system but did not cover periods of vacancy of premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Weyerhauser, Wisconsin do Ordain:

Section 1. That Ordinance 1-54 adopted January 15, 1954 be modified by this supplementary Ordinance 1-66 and that the rates established by said Ordinance 1-54 be charged to all premises connected to the sewer system, whether vacant or occupied, except

- (a) No charge is to be made if the premise is vacant during the winter period November 1 to March 31.
- (b) No charge to be made when vacant at any other time unless such vacant premise has an open floor or basement drain or some service of the sewer is expected or available.

Section 2. That the established rate be charged at all times unless a written notice is given to the Village Board that the premises are or will be vacated. Periods of vacancy of less than one month will not be recognized.

Section 3. That such charge shall be a lien on the real estate to which the service was furnished and delinquent charges be placed on the tax roll as provided by Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be posted in three public places in the village after its passage, and shall take effect one week after proof of posting has been filed and recorded by the village clerk.
