

VILLAGE OF WEYERHAUSER, WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MINORS UNDER SEVENTEEN (17) YEARS FROM BEING IN OR ABOUT PUBLIC PLACES IN THE VILLAGE DURING CERTAIN HOURS.

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Weyerhauser, Wisconsin do ordain as follows :

SECTION I. No Minor under the age of fourteen (14) years shall be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or other public places, in the Village of Weyerhauser, or loiter in or about railroad depots, restaurants, hotels, taverns, or other public places in said village during the hours set forth below; unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or adult person having custody or unless such minor is required by his employment to be in or about such places as mentioned herein within the hours as stated below, as shown by written evidence by his employer, or such minor is then proceeding to or from his home or place of employment or is on an errand under written instructions in his possession from his parent or guardian.

a. From Sunday evening through Thursday evening the above mentioned acts shall be prohibited from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM.

b. On Friday and Saturday evenings the above mentioned acts shall be prohibited from 11:00 PM to 5:00 AM

SECTION II. No minor under the age of seventeen (17) years shall be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or other public places in the Village of Weyerhauser or loiter in or about railroad depots, restaurants, hotels, taverns, or other public places in said village during the hours set forth below, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or adult person having custody or unless such minor is required by his employment to be in or about the places mentioned herein within the hours stated below, as shown by written evidence by his employer, or such minor is then proceeding to or from his home or place of employment or is on an errand under written instructions in his possession from his parent or guardian.

a. From Sunday evening through Thursday evening the above mentioned acts shall be prohibited from 11:00 PM to 5:00 AM.

b. On Friday and Saturday evenings the above mentioned acts shall be prohibited from 12:00 PM to 5:00 AM

SECTION III. The parents or guardian of any minor found violating the provisions of Section I or II of this Ordinance shall be notified by mail of said violation and upon the second and subsequent offenses said minor will be referred to the Juvenile Court for Rusk County.

SECTION IV. Any parent, guardian or person having custody of a minor under the ages specified in Section I and II hereof, who is warned as provided in Section III, shall, on a second violation of the provisions of Section I or II of this ordinance by a minor in his custody, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) together with costs of prosecution for the first offense, and for subsequent violations shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) together with costs and upon default of payment of any such forfeiture, the defendant shall be confined in the county jail until such costs are paid but not exceeding Thirty (30) days.

SECTION V. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and afters its passage and posting or publication.
