

ORDINANCE No. 12-93-A

Whereas the Village of Weyerhaeuser deems it expedient and necessary that the recycling ordinance be amended to comply with the State Law and DNR regulations regarding recycling in the State of Wisconsin,

NOW THEREFORE THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEYERHAEUSER DOES ORDAIN THAT THE RECYCLING ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WEYERHAEUSER BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

(A) Section 4.10(7) of the Village of Weyerhaeuser Recycling Ordinance is amended and recreated to read as follows:

- (7) "Major Appliance" means a residential or commercial air conditioner, clothes dryer, clothes washer, dishwasher, freezer, microwave oven if the capacitor is not removed, oven, refrigerator or stove, residential and commercial furnaces, boilers, dehumidifiers, and water heaters.

(B) Section 4.11(2) of the Village of Weyerhaeuser Recycling Ordinance amended and recreated to read as follows:

- (2) "Major Appliances including microwave ovens without capacitors removed.

(C) Section 4.12(4) of the Village of Weyerhaeuser Recycling Ordinance is created to read as follows:

- (4) Microwave ovens with capacitors removed may disposed of in landfills in accordance with Section 144.79(7), Wis. Statutes and need not be separated.

(D) Section 4.17 of the Village of Weyerhaeuser Recycling Ordinance hereby is amended and recreated to read as follows:


RESPONSIBILITY OF OWNERS AND/OR DESIGNATED AGENTS OF BUSINESSES AND OTHER NON-RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES.

- 1) Owners or designated agents of businesses and other non-residential facilities shall do all of the following to recycle the materials specified in s. 1.11(5) through (15):
- (a) Provide adequate, separate containers for the recyclable materials.
 - (b) Notify in writing, at least semi-annually, all users, tenants and occupants of the properties about the established recycling program.


- (c) Provide for the collection of the materials separate from the solid waste by the users, tenants and occupants and the delivery of the materials to a recycling facility.
 - (d) Notify users, tenants, and occupants of reason to reduce and recycle, which materials are collected, how to prepare materials in order to meet the processing requirements, collection methods or sites, locations and hours of operation, and a contact person or company, including a name, address, and telephone number.
- 2) The requirements specified in (1) do not apply to the owners or designated agents of businesses and other non-residential facilities and properties if the postconsumer waste generated within the facility or property is treated at a processing facility licensed by the Department of Natural Resources that recovers for recycling the materials specified in s. 1.11(5) through (15) from solid waste in as pure a form as is technically feasible.

This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1995, and upon passage and posting as required by law.
