

ORDINANCE #2.221

REGULATION OF STORAGE OF JUNKED AUTOMOBILES
AND OTHER JUNKED MATERIAL

The Village of Weyerhaeuser do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS:

A. In this section "junk" means any old or scrap metal, metal alloy, synthetic or organic material or waste or any junked, ruined, dismantled or wrecked motor vehicle or machinery or any part thereof.

B. "Screen" means to hide from view in a manner compatible with the surrounding environment.

SECTION 2. PROHIBITIONS: No person, firm, partnership or corporation shall accumulate or store any junk, junked automobiles, stoves or refrigerators, disabled automobiles or parts thereof outside of any building on any real estate located in the Village of Weyerhaeuser except upon a permit issued by the Village Board.

SECTION 3. PERMITS: No permit shall be issued to any applicant who desires to engage only in the business of buying and selling junk unless storage of such junk shall be completely enclosed by a suitable fence which shall completely screen such junk from the view of the public. Permits shall be issued under this ordinance only to applicants who are engaged as a licensed dealer in buying and selling new or used automobiles or who shall be engaged in the business of towing or repairing damaged, disabled or junked automobiles.

SECTION 4. Permittees engaged in a business for which permits may be issued as set forth in Section 3 above shall store such junk, junked automobiles and parts only in such a manner and in such locations in the Village of Weyerhaeuser as the said Village Board shall direct and such permits shall be revoked when the storage of such junk and/or junked automobiles and/or parts shall create an unsightly condition which detracts from the general appearance of the area involved or shall interfere with or detract from the normal use and enjoyment of adjoining property or shall result in creation of a condition which is detrimental to the health, safety and/or welfare of the public.

SECTION 5. All permits issued under this ordinance shall specifically set forth in detail the manner and conditions under which such junk, junked automobiles, stoves, refrigerators and/or parts thereof may be stored in the Village of Weyerhaeuser. Any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a public nuisance and be subject to abatement under the procedures set forth in Ordinance

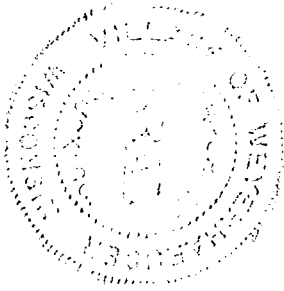
2.22 and in addition, shall subject the violator to a forfeiture of not less than Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense; each day's violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage of publication.
