ORDINANCE NO. 2-81

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND ENHANCE CHAPTER 2.23 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE WITH REFERENCE TO DOGS.

The Village Board of the Village of Weyerhaeuser do ordain as follows:

Section 1 (a). The provisions of Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 174 pertaining to "Dogs" is hereby adopted as part of village ordinances so far as applicable. Former paragraph 1 of Chapter 2.23, Municipal Code, is hereby designated as Section 1(b). Former paragraph 2 is hereby designated as Section 2(a). Former paragraph 3 is hereby designated as Section 3(a).

Section 2(b). No dog shall, negligently or otherwise, be permitted to run at large within the village limits. A dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is unattended and off the premises of the owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person.

Section 3(b). All dogs over the age of 5 months shall be rabies immunized. As proof of immunization a certificate from a veterinarian must be presented before a license shall be issued. The owner of the dog shall annually pay the dog license tax to the village treasurer and obtain a license tag.

Section 3(c). The dog license tax in the village of Weyerhaeuser shall be \$2.00 for a neutered male dog or spayed female dog upon presentation of evidence that the dog is neutered or spayed, and \$5.00 for an unneutered male dog or unspayed female dog. Licenses will expire on December 31 each year.

Section 3(d). All prior village ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after passage and publication.
