ORDINANCE 74-1

A JOINT ACTION EMERGENCY GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE  
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF RUSK AND THE VILLAGE OF  
WEYERHAUSER TO COPE WITH EMERGENCIES RESULTING  
FROM MAN-MADE OR NATURAL DISASTERS.

THE VILLAGE OF WEYERHAUSER DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION I. A Joint Action Ordinance of the Board  
of Supervisors of Rusk County Providing for a County  
-Municipal Joint Action Emergency Government Plan of  
Organization adopted by said County Board on the 20th  
day of March, 1974 is hereby ratified and accepted by  
the Village of Weyerhauser, County of Rusk, and made  
a part hereof, by reference. This ratification and  
acceptance of the Joint Action Ordinance shall consti-  
tute a mutual agreement between the village of Weyer-  
hauser and the county of Rusk as provided by Section  
73.3 of said Joint Action Ordinance.

SECTION II. The County-Municipal Emergency Government  
Director, appointed and employed by the Rusk County  
Board as provided in the referred to Ordinance is here-  
by designated and appointed "Emergency Government Di-  
rector" for the village of Weyerhauser, subject to the  
conditions and provisions as set forth in the Wisconsin  
Statutes, and the Rusk County Joint Action Ordinance.

SECTION III. All ordinances and/or resolutions in con-  
flict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV . This ordinance shall take effect and be  
in force from, and after, its passage and publication.
