ORDINANCE # 90-2(A)
BUILDING PERMITS

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has signed into law the Home Safety Act, effective December 18, 2003, which states that all municipalities are required to provide for inspections for one and two family homes, and that the Village of Weyerhaeuser has adopted the Uniform Dwelling Code, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following ordinance be adopted:

A Building Permit for all NEW one and two family dwellings shall be issued ONLY after plans have been reviewed by the Village's inspection agency and a UDC permit seal has been purchased. UDC inspection for additions or major remodeling of one or two family dwellings built AFTER 1980 will also be required. A Building Permit will also be required for extensive remodeling of existing homes and businesses built before June 1, 1980; as well as a permit needed for garages, trailer homes, outdoor buildings, multi-unit family dwellings and for building razed.


The following fees have been approved by the Village Board:

1. New Homes: Regardless of cost or size - \$25.00 for permit.
2. Alterations, additions, extensive remodeling, garages, multi-unit family dwellings - cost over \$1,000 - \$15.00 for permit.
3. Trailer homes moved, buildings razed - \$15.00 for permit.


This ordinance shall be effective May 1, 2004, upon passage and publication as provided by law.
